

Participants' Responsibilities:

Upon registration:

- Fill out an assessment survey on your knowledge of African art and how you currently teach it
- Submit a lesson plan if you have previously taught on West African art
- Submit agreement form signed by you

Before the Institute begins:

- Study background readings and visual materials provided by the program directors

During the Institute:

- Keep a daily journal of ideas, skills and techniques you acquire during the Institute.
- Participate in evening discussions and presentations Create works of art (glass bead making, weaving, pottery, adinkra stamping, bronze casting)
- Submit assessment narratives, post-Institute survey and begin curriculum development

After the Institute:

- Develop and teach curriculum materials (units, lesson plans) that show evidence of the impact the Institute has made on their teaching about West African art
- Submit reflective narrative on experience of teaching with curriculum materials
- Submit final curriculum materials to program directors.
